

Narragansett Bay Commission Awards Perfect Discharge Record to ChemArt Company

Company invested deeply in state-of-the-art wastewater treatment

LINCOLN, RI – March 2024: ChemArt Company was recognized for a perfect discharge record in 2023 after a total rebuild of its in-house wastewater treatment facility. “We take our environmental health and safety issues very seriously,” said Alfred Silva, EH&S Director at the company. “Our culture and ownership have prioritized this as a critical and primary responsibility and has invested significantly in capital expenditures, training, audits and preventive maintenance,” continued Mr. Silva.

Narragansett Bay Commission (NBC) discharge limits are quite stringent as all things deposited into the sewer eventually find their way to the Narragansett Bay and the Atlantic Ocean. The company is required to regularly test, continuously monitor and routinely report discharge chemistry to the NBC, who also conducts spot audits by drawing their own samples irregularly and comparing these to company reports. A perfect record is always the goal but difficult to achieve. “We are regularly near perfect, but this is a real sign of excellence,” noted Silva

Founded by a U.S. Navy veteran in 1976, ChemArt has three divisions: Beacon Design which makes bespoke keepsakes and ornaments including the official annual White House Christmas Ornament; ChemTecUSA that makes precision parts for Energy, Aerospace, Automotive, Manufacturing, Defense and other sectors; and BLuxe, a maker of high end packaging adornments as well as labels and permanent placards for high end purses, suitcases, and more. 100% of ChemArt Company's manufacturing is in the USA in a vertically integrated ISO 9001-2015 facility.

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
